## CEU Process

GSFA State Secretary will create a data base of all Georgia Master Florists which will include all contact information.

Each District will be responsible to report a roll of GMF's for each district meeting during the year.

Secretary will email each GMF in January of their reporting year to remind them that CEUs must be reported by December of their reporting year. Forms will be available online on GSFA's web site.

Secretary will log all CEUs from Registration list from Convention, Summer Symposium and any other GSFA sponsored events. However it is still the responsibility of the GMF to report those units.

On January 15<sup>th</sup> following the December 31<sup>st</sup> due date, the Secretary will email the Non-Reporting GMFs with a notice. On February 1<sup>st</sup> a letter will be mailed to the Non-Reporting GMFs with a notice of suspension. Once suspended a Non-Reporting GMF can submit a CEU report and a reinstatement fee of \$50 within 6 months following their December 31<sup>st</sup> due date. After 6 months, the Non-Reporting GMFs must register for the Phase Two of the GMF program which includes an onsite design evaluation and a fee of \$150.

GMF's must maintain annual membership with GSFA to maintain their GMF Certification. GSFA membership is due in April of each year and is valid through March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year. If a GMF fails to pay annual membership to GSFA by June 1<sup>st</sup>, the Non-Member GMF will be suspended. Certification can be reinstated if membership dues are paid within the current fiscal year and the membership dues will not be prorated. If a Non-Member GMF waits till another fiscal year to pay membership dues, they are required to register for Phase Two of the GMF program which includes an onsite design evaluation and a fee of \$150.
